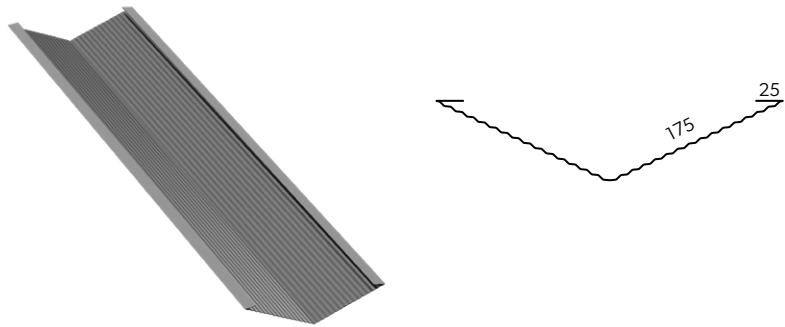

BASKET GUTTER

The basket gutter is a flashing that ensures the collection and drainage of rainwater to the gutter from two independent roof slopes that meet in the so-called basket.

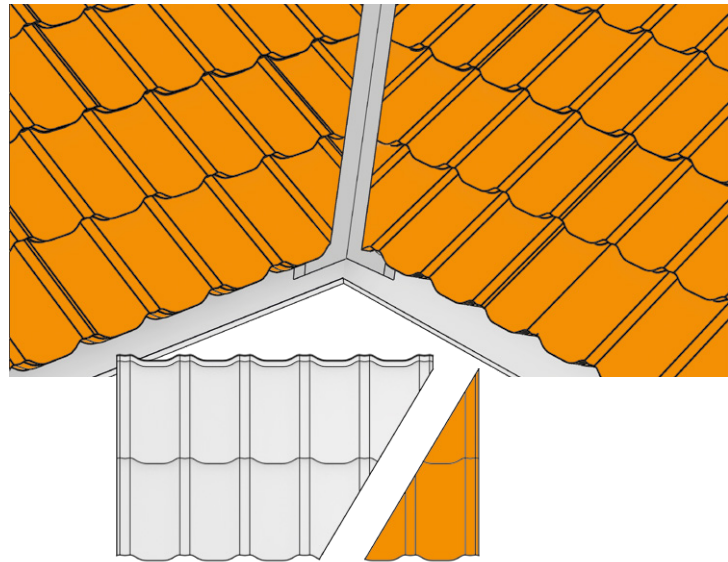

Cut the sheets to the basket gutter in line with the valley, which will ensure an aesthetic finish (**fig. 2**).

As a seal for the basket gutter, we recommend using an expanding gasket up to the height of the sheet metal rib.

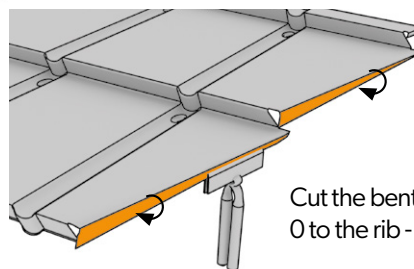
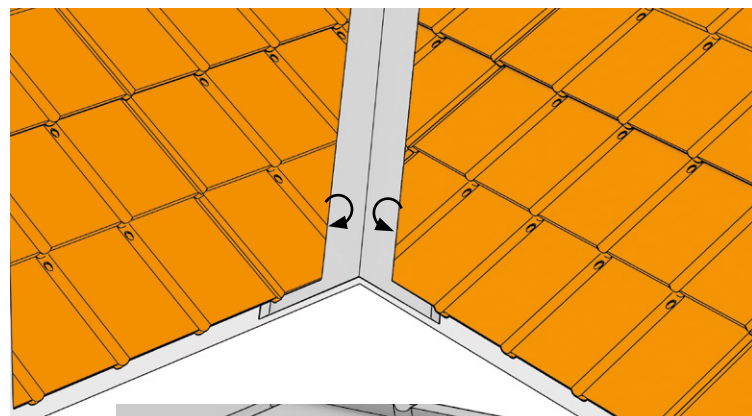

In the case of **IZI** modular metal roof tiles, when cutting the sheets to the basket gutter, an overlap of 3 cm should be provided. This allows the sheet to be bent in the basket line, which will additionally ensure an aesthetic finish (**fig. 3**).

As a seal for the basket gutter, we recommend using an expanding gasket up to the height of the sheet metal rib.

Cut the bent edge at an angle from the base 0 to the rib - 3 cm
